“SCRIPTURE”

Pastor: The grass withers and the flowers fall, but the word of our God stands forever. Continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it;

Congregation: And how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

Pastor: All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting, and training in righteousness;

Congregation: So that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

Pastor: For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

Congregation: Nothing in all creation is hidden from God’s sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

Pastor: We did not follow cleverly invented stories when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, but we were eyewitnesses of His majesty.

Congregation: For He received honor and glory from God the Father when the voice came to Him from the Majestic Glory, saying, This is my Son, whom I love; with Him I am well pleased.

Pastor: We ourselves heard this voice that came from heaven when we were with Him on the sacred mountain.

Congregation: And we have the word of the prophets made more certain, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.

Pastor: Above all, you must understand that no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet’s own interpretation.

Congregation: For prophecy never had its origin in the will of man, but men spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit.
